Haymon, Infant Stillborn - 20 Aug 1933 Birth date: June 28, 1933 (unnamed) Haymon, Louie - 3 Mar 1935 / 10 Jun 1935 Louis Elijah Haymon

[above 2 burials have double stone] –

Sons of Elijah & Etta [Cryer] Haymon; Etta Cryer is daughter of John Columbus Cryer. John Columbus Cryer is a son of William Riley Cryer (1862-1944) and Missouri Elizabeth Whitley (1864-1947).

John Columbus is buried at Zion Hill and William and Missouri are buried at Cooper Cemetery, Junction, Beauregard Ph, LA.

Etta and Elijah are both buried at Mt. Bethel Baptist Church Cemetery, Vernon Ph, LA

John Columbus married Mae Augusta Jeane daughter of James William Jeane and cousin Laura Cordelia Jeane, both grandchildren of James Monroe Jeane. Mae is buried at Mitchell Cemetery, Vernon Ph, LA. James and Laura are buried at Cooper Cemetery, Pickering, Vernon Ph, LA

William Riley Cryer is son of William Honor Cryer probably buried at Cryer Cemetery, Allen Ph, LA and Margaret Ann Williams buried at Zion Hill. Missouri Elizabeth Whitley is daughter of Christopher Columbus Whitley and Malissie Caroline Patterson. C. C. and Malissie are buried at Caney Creek Cemetery, Allen Ph, LA.

Cryer, Johnnie - [no dates] [son of Levi Cryer] Born, 1883, died unknown. John H. Cryer son of Honor Levi Cryer and Mary Elizabeth Bass. Cryer, Tom - [no dates] [son of Levi Cryer] Born, 1890, died unknown. Thomas L.Cryer son of Honor Levi Cryer and Mary Elizabeth Bass. Cryer, ? - [no dates] Possibly an infant of Honor Levi and Mary Elizabeth. [above 3 burials in a row with almost unreadable old-style, small concrete markers] Honor Levi is a son of William Honor Cryer and Margaret Ann Williams and a brother to William Riley Cryer (1862-1944). Honor Levi is buried at Beulah Cemetery, Sabine Ph, LA, with his wife Mary Elizabeth Bass daughter of Moses Bass and Rachael Eaves.

William Honor Cryer is probably buried at Cryer Cemetery, Allen Ph, LA and Margaret Ann Williams is buried in this cemetery, Zion Hill.

Craft, William J. - 27 Dec 1896 / 27 Sep 1938 [son of Fred Craft] s/o John Frederick Craft and Mary Jane Hall and a brother to John F. Craft. William Craft married Blanche Cordelia Jeane a sister to Mae Augusta Jeane married to James Columbus Cryer. Blanch is buried at Cold Springs Cemetery, Vernon Ph, LA.

John F. Craft married Mary Ella Cryer, daughter of William Riley Cryer and Missouri Elizabeth Whitley. William Riley farmed on Whiskey Chitto and when he retired from farming, John F. and Ella bought the farm and lived there until the military take-over.

Craft, Infant - b&d 1937 [almost unreadable stone] [son of W. J. Craft] A stillborn infant born October 02, 1937, to William J. Craft and Blanche Cordelia Jeane.

Hall, Luvicy Ann [Mathis], wife of J.T. [John Tom] Hall - 16 Apr 1853 / 24 Mar 1926 Mother Daughter of Thomas Edmond Mathis and Sarah Cruz Hall, John T.[Tom] - 12 Jan 1840 / 22 Sep 1925 [son of J. R. John Randolph & Caroline Hall Ann Caroline Luvicy Collins] Parents of Elizabeth Levicy Hall who married Marion Monroe Whitley

Whitley, Marion M. - 27 Jun 1876 / 13 Dec 1937 Father Marion Monroe Whitley son of Christopher Columbus Whitley and a brother to Missouri Elizabeth Whitley married to William Riley Cryer. Marrion Monroe Cryer, son of William Riley Cryer and Missouri Elizabeth Whitley named after him. Name passed down to Marrion Monroe Cryer, Jr. Whitley, Elizabeth Levicy Hall- 7 Jan 1883 / 7 Jul 1959 Mother Wife of Marion Monroe Whitley

[daughter of John Tom Hall & Louvicy Ann Mathis] [above 2 burials have double stone] Whitley, James T. - 3 Sep 1899 / 12 Jan 1981 Dad James Thomas Whitley son of Marion Monroe Whitley and Elizabeth Levicy Hall, married to Cora Malora Jeane.

Whitley, Cora J. [Malora] - 29 May 1900 / 15 Nov 1991, 91 yrs 5 mos 16 das Mom Cora Malora Jeane daughter of James William Jean and Laura Cordelia Jeane

Whitley, Infant son of J. T. & Cora Whitley - 28 Feb 1925 / 28 Feb 1925 Son of James Thomas Whitley and Cora Malora Jeane

Nash, Infant of M&M Willie Nash - b&d 2 Nov 1928 infant of William Nash and Thelma Cryer daughter of John Columbus Cryer and Mae Augusta Jeane.

Jean [sic], Infant daughter of G. N. & M. C. Jean - b&d 28 Oct 1911 Daughter of Gilbert Newton Jeane and Margaret Caroline Cryer

Jeane, Addy (Audie) – January 28, 1912 / 1918 [almost unreadable, birth date taken from 1977 cemetery reading] Daughter of Gilbert Newton Jeane and Margaret Caroline Cryer Jeane, Margaret [Cryer], wife of G. N. Jeane - 5 Apr 1893 / 15 Jul 1919 Mother Margaret Caroline Cryer married to Gilbert Newton Jeane. Margaret carries the name of her mother Margaret Ann Williams.

[daughter of William Riley Cryer & Missouri** Elizabeth Whitley] Jeane, Gilbert N. - 9 Jun 1886 / 24 May 1972 <<u>Gilbert Newton Jeane son of Henry Pamplin</u> Jeane and Mary E. Smith, married to Margaret Caroline Cryer

Whitley - 7 Dec 1903 / 7 Dec 1903 Whitley, Infant daughter of M. M. & L. E. Cryer, James Honor - 11 Sep 1898 / 22 Aug 1899 Son of William Riley Cryer and Missouri Elizabeth Whitley.

Cryer, Ann - [no dates] [mother of William Riley Cryer] May 1830-after 1910 Margaret Ann Williams wife of William Honor Cryer.

Hall, Infant of T. J. Hall - 17 Nov 1884 / 17 Nov 1884 Probably an infant of John Tom Hall and Luvicy Ann Mathis

Hall, Caroline, wife of John R. Hall - 16 Aug 1812 / 15 Jun 1903 Mother Ann Caroline Luvicy Collins wife of John Robert Hall parents of John Tom Hall the father of John F. Craft married Mary Ella Cryer.

Shavers, Donald - 1939 / 1940 Shavers, William - 1938 / 1938 Shavers, Infant son of H. N. Shavers - 1938 / 1938 Son of Henry Norris Shavers, son of Frank Oliver Shavers and Mary Jane Hall, married Estell Olar Jeane, a sister to Mae Augusta Jeane. Both are buried in Hooks Cemetery, Hardin Co, Texas

William Westley is buried at Legion Memorial Cemetery, Newellton, Tensas Ph, LA, and Laura Ann is buried at Cryer Cemetery, Oakdale, Allen Ph, LA.

Veelmore is a son of Hezekiah Haymon, Jr. buried in this cemetery, Mill Creek and Georgiana McKee buried in Brack Cemetery. Edith is a daughter of John Columbus Cryer, son of William Riley Cryer and Missouri Elizabeth Whitley and Mae Augusta Jeane, daughter of James William Jeane and Laura Cordelia Jeane both buried in the Cooper Cemetery, Pickering, Vernon Ph, LA.

Cryer, Oda A. Davis - b Jan 31, 1900 / d May 04, 1937 (w/o George Cryer, d/o William Jefferson Davis & Adeline Jane Self, grand daughter of William Gordon Davis, father of William Jefferson Davis)

George Richard Cryer is a son of William Riley Cryer and Missouri Elizabeth Whitley who farmed north of his father in the Zion Hill area. He is buried at Flatwoods Cemetery, Rapides Ph, LA.

Cryer, William A. - b 1926 / d 1928 (s/o George & Oda A. Davis Cryer) Son of George Richard Cryer and Oda A. Davis. George Richard was named after William Riley's oldest brother, George Richard Cryer born 1849.

Swain, John Alvin - 29 Mar 1895 / 7 Dec 1950 [son of Dick Swain & Eliza Young] 2nd husband of Della Cryer, daughter of William Riley Cryer and Missouri Elizabeth Whitley. Della Cryer buried at Good Hope Cemetery, Anacoco, Vernon Ph, LA.
