

The year of 1991 brought many changes to the cemeteries of the Fort Polk rifle range. One of the changes was the placement on the unmarked graves of Haymon family members. Family members knew the grave sites but circumstances, time, finances kept them from placing headstones.

The placement of headstones was started by Doris Dolly Mayo, Dempsey Haymon, Wayne Haymon, Gene Haymon, along with others. Headstones were purchased and placed by these family members. The headstone of the infant daughter of William Cullen Haymon, placed by this group has disappeared from the site. The site is now marked by 4x4 wooden posts. The website indicates the birth and death dates as 2-10-1919. This information has been verified by the following Ronald Z. Haymon-brother, Gwendole Haymon-sister, Vonda Kelly-sister, Wynonia Haymon-sister-in-law and Wayne Haymon-cousin.
